

Developing Middle Leadership- learning to lead

Target audience: RQTs (2-5 years) and Middle leaders (new to the role) that are looking at 'Taking the Lead' in delivering a whole school initiative. This will support them in the development of their leadership role whilst having a whole school impact!

RQTs that have trained via the School Direct Route (St Mary and St Thomas' CE Alliance) will receive a FREE place on this programme.

The programme will follow the NPQ competencies and professional standards that underpin the programme. This is a successful professional development programme

designed to assist senior leadership teams in succession planning and building capacity of teachers to enhance school leadership.

This includes: 4 face-to face sessions, personal needs analysis; process led training; development of leadership skills; and a final presentation identifying impact of the programme on delegate's leadership learning and school improvement.
