Why we exist

Our vision is for every child to enjoy and succeed in mathematics, regardless of background.

Our mission is to transform mathematics education in the UK. We work in partnership to empower and equip schools to deliver world-class mathematics teaching.

The difference we make

Our programme develops and supports teachers in every aspect of their teaching.

In 2016-17 we are working with 366 schools and 97 000 pupils are taught lessons developed by Mathematics Mastery.

Costs

The cost of the Mathematics Mastery programme in your first year is £6,450.

Schools in the St. Helen's region are eligible to apply for match-funding, reducing this cost to £3,225.

Alternatively, we offer a 30% discount for one form entry primary schools reducing the cost to £4,515.
